

- a) When the Biddeford to Emmons Road, Kennebunk section is complete this year, it should be used and not left unused for a year until the turnpike bridge and the route connection is made to Rt. 35.
  - b) An entirely new on-road route will be needed for Biddeford. All Arundel signs will need to be removed.
  - c) Mike Claus described a temporary on-road route that Kennebunk could sign from the Emmons Road temporary end of the KAB section to an appropriate connection on the current on-road route.
  - d) A new sign design will be needed this year if the number of signs removed is inadequate to mark the new on-road route.
